C. Community Consideration

- Successfully led the team on behalf of the Gelephu based stones exporters to lobby with the Royal Government seeking its intervention by directing the banks to support stones export finance to the exporters of Gelephu and Bhutan. The Bhutan National Bank Ltd. (BNBL) has come out with Procedure Guidelines for Export Credit mainly against the security of Letters of Credit. This exercise and negotiation were carried out from April- July 2021.
- In September 2020, during the first nationwide unprecedented covid-19 pandemic lockdown has successfully formed an elected committee through virtual election which was participated by about 60 exporters from Gelephu. This initiative was very nature of the COVID-19 crisis

calls for a response that calls for Gyal-Lyon-Bang Sum (King, Government and People) cooperation and collaboration at its very core and forge partnerships in mitigating the worst effects of the pandemic which will help protecting jobs and supporting families, generating revenue and rebuilding economy. Have submitted written request to the RGoB to pursue approval of Joghigopa IWT port with the government of India.




